at Cape Northumberland

The Cape Northumberland Little Penguin Colony has been the victim of predators since April 2016 and the population has been severely impacted. We can't confirm if there are birds present at this time.

There is a possibility that the Little Penguins could return to the site but it is difficult to predict how long this will take, and if they do return, the ongoing impact of predators will continue to be an issue.

Foxes, dogs and cats are Little Penguin predators. Wandering pet dogs and cats can be as much of an issue as foxes.

Please be aware there is a fox baiting program in place for protection of beach nesting birds, which is coordinated by Natural Resources SE, but baiting is not possible in the township area.
