Experience Nature

Kanawinka Geotrail

Start your journey through Australia's most extensive volcanic province from one of our local landmarks; Mount Schank, Ewens Ponds or Piccaninnie Ponds. Covering the south east of South Australia and south west of Victoria, the Kanawinka Geotrail explores thousands of years of well-preserved ancient landscape with over 60 sites enabling visitors to experience a range of features including dormant volcanoes, beautiful waterfalls, lakes, sinkholes, caves and unique coastal formations.

The Jetty & Saint Mary of the Cross MacKillop

Enjoy fishing off the jetty, or imagine the thoughts of Australia's first Saint as she waited to board a ship to Adelaide in 1867 to found a school dedicated to the children of the poor and begin living dependant on divine providence.

Admella Discovery Trail

The wreck of the SS Admella in 1859 was the beginning of a horrific week for survivors who remained on board, in sight of land, while volunteers struggled to rescue them. Follow their stories on a self-drive tour.

Cape Northumberland Heritage and Nature Park

Experience the magnificent rugged coastline, natural vegetation and uninterrupted ocean views at South Australia's most Southerly Point. Site of South Australia's first mainland lighthouse built in 1858; a replacement had to be built in 1882 after the pounding surf eroded the cliff.

Little Penguin Colony

View the Little Penguins (also known as Fairy Penguins) in their natural habitat each dusk and dawn from the viewing platform at Cape Northumberland.

*Free activity. Lighthouse Road. BYO torch. Stay clear of cliff edge. **Map no. 5***

Coastal Carvings

The Southern Ocean has been carving impressions for thousands of years. Formations known as Rhino, Frog, Crocodile, Camel, Lobster Pot Rocks and Map of Australia Reef can all be seen from Cape Northumberland and the viewing platform built over the Old Lighthouse site.

Bi-centennial Turret

A gentle walk to the top of the curving turret allows views of Mount Schank, Mount Gambier, Cape Northumberland and Cape Douglas.

Petrified Forest and Wagon Wheel Tracks

Clearly seen at low tide, the wheel tracks were carved into the granite by the bullock team wagons carrying wool, pebbles and other items to the state's second busiest port 150 years ago. The strange, rocky outcrops are known as the Petrified Forest but actually aren't petrified wood. *Free Activity. Sea Parade (carpark opposite site). **Map no. 9***

Bird Watching

View at least 55 types of Pelagic Birds from the sea on one of Port MacDonnell's fishing charter boats or visit one of the local bird hides.

***Map no. 11** and Eight Mile Creek Road.*

Adam Lindsay Gordon's Cottage at Dingley Dell Conservation Park

Once home to Australian poet Adam Lindsay Gordon, the cottage offers a glimpse of 1860's life. A self-guided walking trail meanders through the surrounding bush. Guided group tours available.

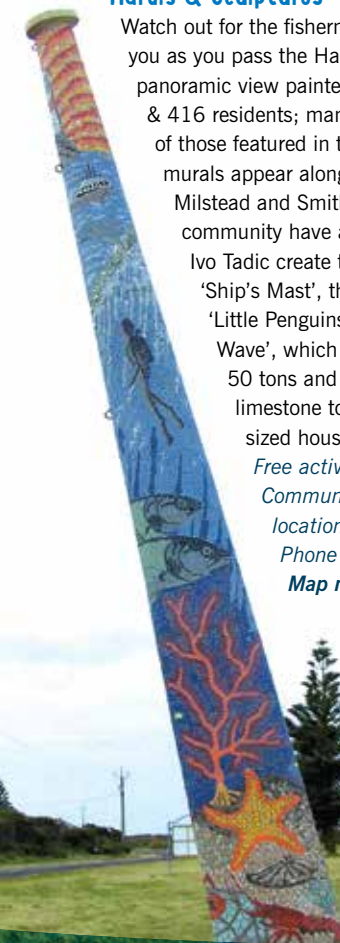

Murals & Sculptures

Watch out for the fishermen that follow you as you pass the Hall, which features a panoramic view painted by Kathy Mabon & 416 residents; many descendants of those featured in the mural. Other murals appear along Lower Nelson, Milstead and Smiths Roads. The community have also helped sculptor Ivo Tadic create the majestic mosaic 'Ship's Mast', the cute but large 'Little Penguins', and the 'Bay Wave', which weighs about 50 tons and contains enough limestone to build a medium sized house.

Customs House

Built in 1863, it combined the Harbour Master's office, police station & residence, cells, court house, customs house, post & telegraph office with residence & a teacher's residence.

German Mine and War Memorial

View the War Memorial and German mine that was filled with hexonite explosive and weighed quarter of a ton when it washed up in the town in 1943.

Woolwash Historical Reserve. Pioneer Path. & Historic Trail

Visit the Woolbales and learn about Cress Creek, once used for washing wool for trade. Find the murdered Captain Broadfoot's memorial. Walk along the Pioneers Path or drive the Historic Trail and learn about the Town's characters and early history.
